Spring Bird Count

Saturday, May 7

The Spring Bird Count is a yearly bird count on the Saturday between May 4th and 10th. Each Illinois county has a compiler responsible for recruiting volunteers and assigning them to survey areas.

Volunteers record all birds seen or heard, along with the number of hours they spend "owling" (pre-dawn hours) and looking for birds during the day, as well as the number of miles driven and walked.




